Considering crop insurance?

Sign up today, and the Province will pay 50% of your producer premium for 2025, 2026 and 2027 crop seasons.

About Acreage Loss Insurance

The Crop Insurance Plan for Acreage Loss provides protection against vegetable crop production losses caused by designated perils.

Insurable Perils:

- Frost (May 1 – September 30)
- Hail
- Drought
- Wind
- Adverse Weather

I am pleased that the Province, in partnership with Horticulture Nova Scotia, is decreasing farm's crop insurance premiums by 50 percent in the Acreage Loss Plan for 2025-27. This initiative was developed from the innovative ideas of the Business Risk Management Review Working Group. Deadlines and Eligibility

For 2025 - apply quickly - before June 30, 2025.
For 2026 and 2027, apply by March 30 each year.

Each season, you must pay your premium by August 31 to have 50% of your premium paid.

Field Inspections:

Before approval for insurance and at intervals during the growing season, NSCLIC staff will inspect crops for best management practices and damage.
